After 15 years of serving as the Executive Director of the Lighthouse, I am still amazed at the depth of drug addiction and heartache that runs rampant around us.

As I've shared in a previous newsletter, I was moved by God to take action to offer more hope from the Lighthouse after meeting with several couples in one week who shared stories of addiction, jail, prostitution, homelessness, and lost kids. It's not easy to get your life together without hope.

Those meetings were the launch pad for a church at the Lighthouse. We have a harvest ground of souls who come to eat at our facility twice a day. We have been seeing change since the launch of The Journey East in April. God is moving and we are bringing hope to those who are lost.

In partnership with the church, we are embarking on a second new adventure this year and opening a transition house for women. The Rachel House is a faith based, non-profit, transitional home for women in addiction recovery. It exists to offer women a place to find freedom, renewed hope, and rebuild their lives once they have completed their inpatient rehab program.

We believe that true freedom from addiction comes through faith in Jesus Christ. God has placed a call on our hearts to help as many women as possible that are broken and trapped in the disease of addiction find freedom through Christ.

We closed on a house on August 1, and we are working to begin receiving applicants in October. We have room for six women and a house manager. If you would like to help, please contact the office.

Our charity event, the Better Together Gala, is next month. We would love to see you there. I am so excited about the venue, food, speaker and silent auction items.
