2025 started with an arctic blast! Bitter wind chills, dangerous snow and ice hazards, and a heating unit that wasn't working made January a month we won't soon forget.

Despite these challenges, our staff and volunteers worked diligently to meet the needs of neighbors experiencing homelessness and hunger. On the coldest days, with few staff and volunteers and limited heat, we were open for lunch to serve anyone who needed a hot meal and a respite from the weather.

Through your kindness and support, our mission-centered ministry continues important and much-needed work. Our meal program, Dining with Dignity, is one of the best soup kitchens in Kentucky and serves 80-100 people per meal. We serve healthy and hearty lunches and dinners seven days a week, along with helpings of hope through the Lord's word.

Our Clean Start program, now in its second year, is the only program in Lexington's East End where people living on the streets can walk in and get a hot shower. The ministry is evolving to provide more services.

From humble beginnings, the Lighthouse has grown into an organization that, as a vital community partner, strives to meet basic human needs. We have the potential to do much more. OPENING DOORS



Our Clean Start program serves as a one-stop shop to meet hygiene needs and help clients gain necessary life skills. Through community partnerships, we now provide targeted case management, mental health counseling. and art therapy. Our staff assists with referrals to 30+ local organizations that address needs such as housing. addiction recovery, medical care, and job preparation and placement.

SUCCESS STORIES

Dennis, 62, was living in a tent and came to the Lighthouse for meals and showers. Through available resources, he now receives Social Security, has his medications monitored, gets Snap benefits, Medicaid, and lives in a small apartment.



Antone, 24, lived in his car for six months after leaving college and experiencing the loss of his mother. He approached Clean Start for a shower and clothing. He was referred to Jubilee Jobs for job readiness training, received money management training, grief counseling, help with apartment applications, locating household items, and support. Antone is now employed, has an apartment, and has returned to school.
